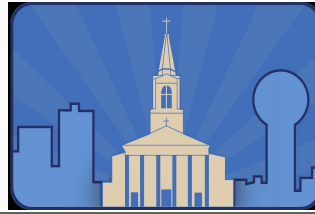

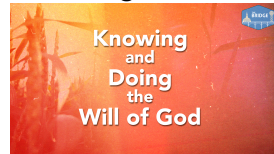
### Easter Breakfast
