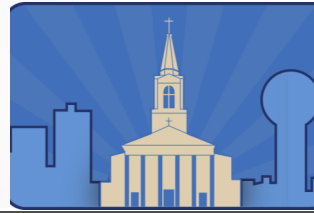

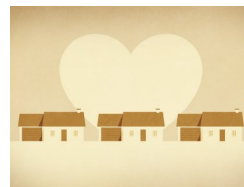


Volunteers for Food Co-Op

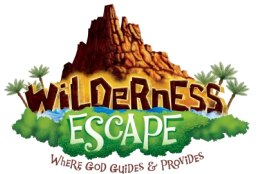
Church Directory is HERE!
