REDEMPTION... *A Journey through Matthew's Gospel*

This week's reading calls us to Matthew 22 & 23. You can find the video and the discussion questions at http://www.fbcknox.org/redemption/ Let me encourage you to make the time to read along with us so that this great gospel might have the fullest opportunity to speak into your life.



Last week's sermon took us into the streets of Jerusalem with Jesus. Now, we find Jesus surrounded, doubted, and questioned. This week's sermon is entitled, "Whose Son Is He?" and emerges from Matthew 22:41-46. It is one of the many times those in religious leadership questioned the authority of Jesus. We do not talk a lot about spiritual authority, but this passage invites us to take a closer look at the core issue which is on what authority we base our lives with Jesus. There are many who wonder if these stories are real, or if the gospel really matters. There are still others willing to embrace Jesus as Savior, but who wonder if the idea of "lordship" really matters. What about us? Who do we say Jesus is, not just inside the walls of the church, but in the way we live out our lives?
