*Tuesday, April 1, 10 am, Room 302*

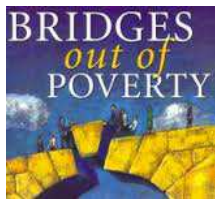

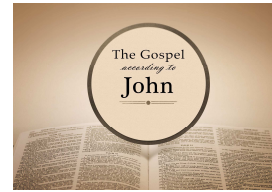

## FBC Golf Tournament

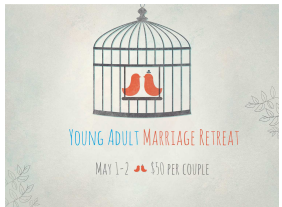
*Sunday, April 27, at 2 pm, with a shotgun start at Three Ridges Golf Course*
