Easter Breakfast

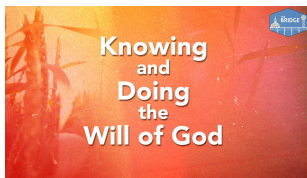
Sunday, April 20, 9:30 am, Trentham Hall
