*Read: John 6:1 - 6:71*

***Questions for Reflection ...***

After feeding the crowd, Jesus had to withdraw himself because He knew they wanted to make Him king by force. Yet by the end of the chapter, many turn back from following Jesus. Why did they change their opinion of Jesus so quickly? How do you react when your experiences of Jesus contradict your expectations of Jesus?

What is Jesus trying to accomplish by feeding the crowd, walking on water, and performing other miraculous signs? Jesus says, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one He has sent." Do you ever find that difficult or find yourself asking for another sign? What miracles is God doing in your life right now?

Why did the twelve stay with Jesus even as the others left? Would you have stayed? Do you share their confession that Jesus is the Holy One of God? Why? Does it surprise you that Jesus chose the twelve, knowing one of them would betray him? What does that tell you about the love of Jesus?
