### *Questions for Reflection ...*

*Despite Jesus seeming reluctant, his first miracle comes at the request of his mother, and it ultimately leads to good wine. What does this story tell you about Jesus? Do you have places in your life where you feel "my time has not yet come", but others are encouraging you to live into your potential?*

*Jesus drives merchants and money-changers away from the temple. Does this image connect with your understanding of who Jesus is? Jesus' zeal for God's house is obvious. Where are your passions being displayed?*

*John 3:16 is perhaps the best known verse of the New Testament. How does the story of Nicodemus, the Pharisee coming at night to Jesus, add context to or reshape your understanding of this verse?*
