Read: John 7:1 - 8:30

Questions for Reflection ...

In this week's passage Jesus seems very concerned about the proper timing of his ministry, and he is not seized because 'His time had not yet come.' What timetable was Jesus following? Are you ever anxious about things happening too slowly or too quickly in your life? What might this passage be teaching you about God's timing?

When you read the story of the woman caught in adultery (8:1-11) which character(s) do you most identify with? Do you more often find yourself judging others or being the subject of judgment? How does Jesus' mercy for this woman impact your life?

The people of Jerusalem had many varied opinions about Jesus; verse 43 says, "Thus the people were divided because of Jesus." Why do you think some believed and some did not? Where have you seen Jesus cause division? From what Jesus says in this passage, would you be willing to put your faith in Him?
