Questions for Reflection ...

Some Jews challenged Jesus saying, "If you are the Christ, tell us plainly." When He tells them plainly, how do they respond? As you have read the Gospel of John, what claims have you seen Jesus make? How do you respond to each of those claims? Which of Jesus' claims are most difficult for you to accept? Why?

If Jesus is truly your Good Shepherd, how will your relationship with Jesus be impacted? What do you do when you are uncomfortable with where the Good Shepherd leads, or with those the Good Shepherd adds to the flock? Thomas said, "Let us go also, that we may die with Him." Are you willing to be that bold in following the good shepherd?

How would you describe the faith of Mary and Martha, before Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead? How do you think their brother's resurrection transformed their faith? What do you think Lazarus' life was like after resurrection? Where have you seen Jesus bring life from death? How could Jesus' command to "take off the grave clothes and let him go," be applied to your life today?
