Questions for Reflection ...

Jesus washes His disciples feet, then gives a new command to “love one another”. How are serving others and loving others connected? Is it possible to serve without loving? Is it possible love without serving? Do you ever find yourself doing one without the other? Does your love for other believers currently identify you as a disciple of Jesus?

Are you surprised that Jesus included Judas in the foot-washing, even knowing Judas was going to betray Him? Do you think it was difficult for Jesus to include Judas? Jesus says, “I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you.” If you followed Jesus pattern whose feet would you wash today?

Peter boldly proclaims he will follow Jesus even if it means death, but Jesus asks Peter a probing question: “Will you really lay down your life for me?” What claims do you make about your commitment to follow Jesus? Would those claims hold up to direct questioning from Jesus? Are you willing to ask for grace to be more faithful?
