Read: John 14:1 - 15:17

Questions for Reflection ...

Having predicted His own betrayal and death, Jesus addresses His disciples' fear and uncertainty about the future. How do His promises give you comfort for the future? Jesus also tells His disciples they will do even greater things than He has done. Do you believe you are doing "greater things"? Why or why not?

Jesus says the world will not see nor know the coming Holy Spirit, but that the Holy Spirit will live in the disciples, teaching them all things, and reminding them of all Jesus said. Do you know the Holy Spirit? How is the Holy Spirit active in your life as a disciple of Jesus?

Calling Himself the True Vine, Jesus offers a picture of what it means to be connected to and nourished by Him. Jesus says His Father's glory comes as His disciples bear much fruit and show themselves to be His disciples. How do you stay connected to The Vine? What fruit are you bearing as Jesus' disciple? How are you being the loving hands and feet of Jesus to those in need of love today?
