Read: John 17:1-26

Questions for Reflection ...

Jesus says eternal life is to know the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom God sent. Does that match your definition of eternal life? What does eternal life look like here and now?

Jesus makes it clear that we, His followers, are to remain in the world with a purpose. As is sometimes said, “in the world, but not of the world.” Do you find it more difficult to be “in the world” or “not of the world”? Why? How does one do both?

Jesus prayed for His disciples and all who would believe their message. Jesus prayed for you. How does that change the way you read His prayer? Does the unity of Christians mirror the unity of the Father and the Son, as Jesus prayed it would? Who in the Christian family do you find difficulty uniting with? What step will you take today to be one with them?
