Read: John 18:1-19:42

Questions for Reflection ...

When Jesus is arrested, He goes willingly, but asks that His disciples be set free. Why was Jesus determined to accept, “the cup the Father has given,” alone? Why did Jesus emphasize not losing the ones the Father had given Him (6:39)? What does this tell you about Jesus and His relationship with His disciples?

In one chapter, Peter goes from fighting to defend Jesus to denying his relationship with Jesus. When your faith is challenged, are you more likely to fight or flee? Were either of Peter’s reactions the proper response to the situation? What would Jesus say to you in similar situations?

As you meditate on the story of the crucifixion, what element of the story impacts you most deeply? Why? Put yourself in the place of the disciples that first Good Friday, not knowing Easter is coming. What emotions would you be feeling?
